RE: Treaty Negotiations Communications Survey

Dear Tla-o-qui-aht Member,

Tla-o-qui-aht First Nations treaty negotiations are progressing steadily. The negotiation team is working to complete an Agreement-in-Principle (Stage 5 of the treaty process) by fall 2011. Once completed the negotiators will work towards a Final Agreement (Stage 6 of the treaty process). The Final Agreement negotiations may take 1 to 2 years to complete.

While negotiations continue, the Tla-o-qui-aht Negotiation Steering Committee would like to provide you with more information so you can make an informed decision about the treaty. For this reason, we are asking Tla-o-qui-aht Members to complete a confidential survey. **All responses will be kept confidential.** Most importantly, your responses will allow us to be more effective in providing you information as negotiations progress.
